International Indoor Soccer Arena Code of Conduct

ABUSE POLICY

Simply put, soccer is for everyone. This means that anyone who is involved in creating the indoor soccer community we all enjoy – staff, players, referees, fans, etc. – has the right to participate unimpeded from **abuse of any kind**, whether physical, sexual, emotional, verbal, or other. Verbal abuse includes, but is certainly not limited to, insulting, threatening, mocking, or demeaning another person in regard to that person's race, gender, religion, nationality/ethnicity, appearance, sexual orientation, or age.

Proven abuse will be met with fines, suspensions, and if warranted, permanent bans. Let's all focus on the beautiful game and nothing more!

PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

- 1) Show respect for league referees and officials at all times. Referees are a crucial part of the game, and while they are not perfect (same way as players are not) they do their best to be fair and call the game properly. If there is an issue with the referee, we encourage you to speak with them, or our staff, calmly about any disagreements or file a complaint at the front desk, but do not abuse them, as per our Abuse Policy above. Remember, without the referee, there is no game.
- 2) **Respect your opponents.** Similarly, keep in mind that without an opposing team, there wouldn't be a match to play every week! We welcome competition and understand that games can get intense, but let's leave that intensity on the field and stay under control. We encourage teammates to hold each other accountable and responsibly diffuse situations when necessary. If winning is the end goal, we encourage you to chase those professional dreams.
- 3) **Respect the facilities.** We ask that you clean up after yourselves; refrain from damaging property by slamming or kicking doors, spitting on the field, or otherwise compromising the integrity of the arena; and ensure all children are attended to throughout your visit (for their safety as well).
- 4) Learn and abide by the rules of the game. See our website or front desk for the house rules.
- 5) **Learn and abide by league policies.** Be familiar with IISA Adult League policies concerning player eligibility, roster restrictions, and use of guest players.
- 6) Playing while consuming alcohol or drugs is prohibited. Have a beer after the game.
- 7) **Teams are responsible for spectator behavior.** Our expectation is that whoever comes to watch your games and show support abides by the same expectations of the players. Nothing will be tolerated on either side of the glass, so consider them an extension of you.
